### GOD MADE ME, BUT AM I REALLY LOVED????

#### III. THE PERSON YOU'RE BECOMING - B. Really Loved

Do you ever doubt God's love for you, thinking that He has to love you just because He created you? Let's see what the Bible has to say about God's love for you.

1. Ask God to make you especially thankful that you are one of His people and to make you aware of His great love for you.
2. Now, read Isaiah 43: 1-4 to get a better perspective of God's love. As you read this passage, keep in mind that when God speaks to Israel in the Old Testament, He is speaking to His special people. Since Christ's death and resurrection, His people are the Church, the body of Christ...that's you.
3. How does Isaiah describe God's thoughts about His special people?

What does that mean God's thoughts are about you, one of His special people?

Give thanks for that list of His thoughts about you!!!

4. Why should you never be afraid, according to these verses?

5. As a child of God, you are precious in His sight and He loves you very much (see verse 4). But there are times when we all feel "unloved" or "unlovable". When in this last week or two have you felt this way? Tell about it.

Thank God that He loves you even when you feel like that!!

6. Memorize Isaiah 43: 1-4 during this week. Repeat these verses in your mind whenever you don't feel that God love you. Remember that the facts in God's Word are more important than your feelings. Ask God to help your feelings grow from facts.

7. Think of someone you know who might need to hear that God does love them. Call them or write a note, sharing what you learned about God's love today. Use the space below to decide upon what you want to be sure to say.
