IV. THE PROCESS - D. Life Outside the Body of Christ - 1. Your Change

The other day I heard a new Christian saying:

"Now that I've become a Christian I hear so many other Christians talk about 'witnessing.' Maybe it's just that I don't understand what that means, but I want to wince when I think about ramming Christ down someone's throat, or a preaching at that person about all he's done wrong.
