3. What are the qualifications to be a witness in a judicial court?

4. What is the purpose of witnesses in a judicial court?

5. What purpose do you think God has in putting you into the world? (To be what? To do what?)

6. Try an experiment. Reread John 1:6-10, only this time use your own name whenever the passage refers to John the Baptist.

How do you respond to what you just read? What did you learn? How do you feel about it?

7. Now read Matthew 5:14-16.

8. Christ called His followers "the light of the world." Why?

9. According to the passage you just studied in John, where does this light come from?

10. Suppose you receive Christ into your heart, but then neglect to bear witness of Him. According to the passage in Matthew , what are you doing?

11. What is the result of letting your light shine before men?

12. What will you do to let your light shine this coming week? (Your ideas should include what you will do in both words and actions.)

With whom will you do this?

Where will you do this?

14. Pray that God will give you a deep desire to be a good witness for Christ.
