RESSURR...WHAT?

II. THE PERSON YOU'VE MET - B. JESUS CHRIST - 4. His Resurrection--

Resurrection—that's Christ's rising from the dead and becoming alive again. One cannot speak of, or learn about, the death of Christ without immediately turning to the Resurrection. They belong together as one event. If Christ had died but not risen, all the implications of His death would be invalidated. The Resurrection proved that He was who He said He was, and that His death accomplished all He said it would.
